



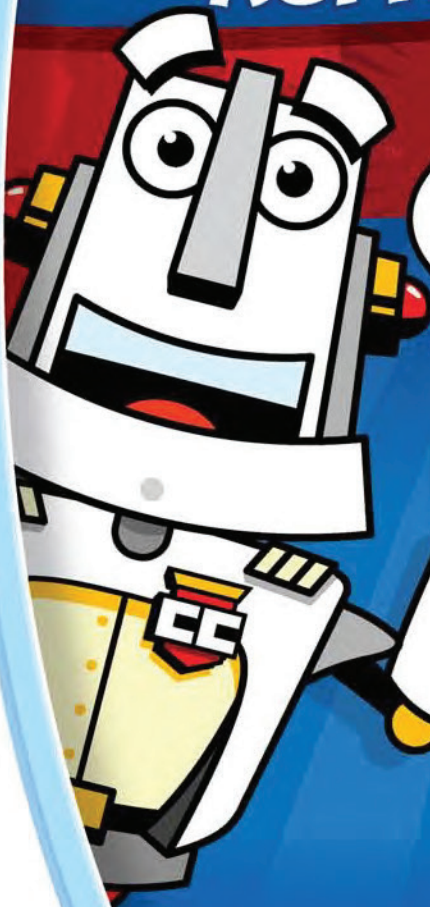

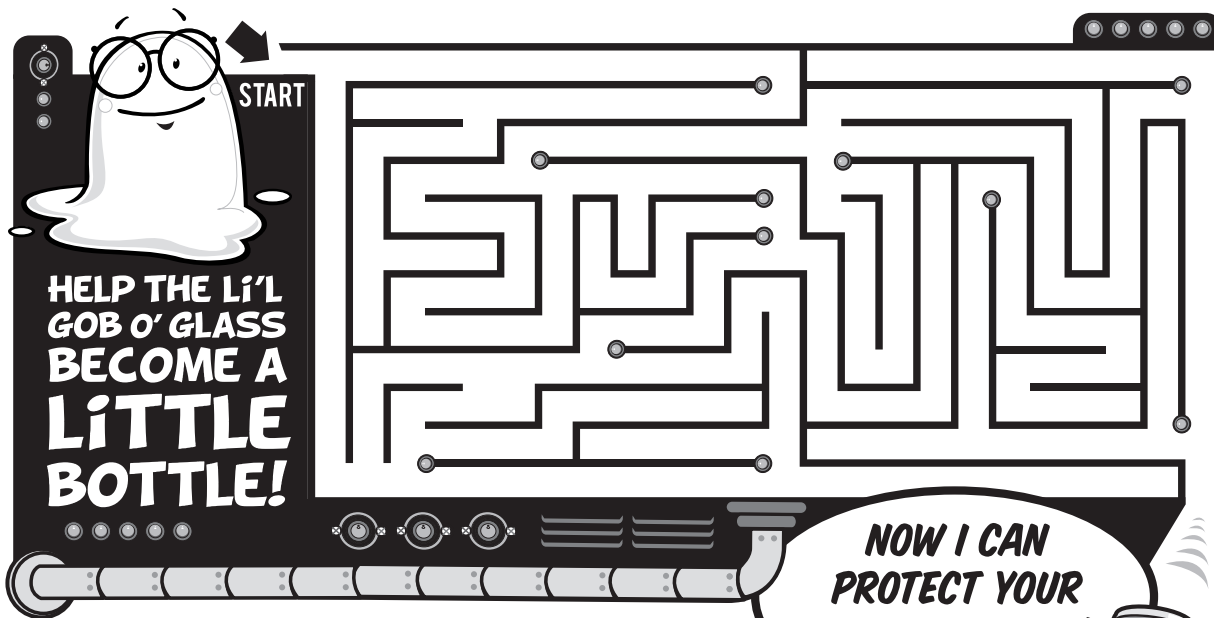

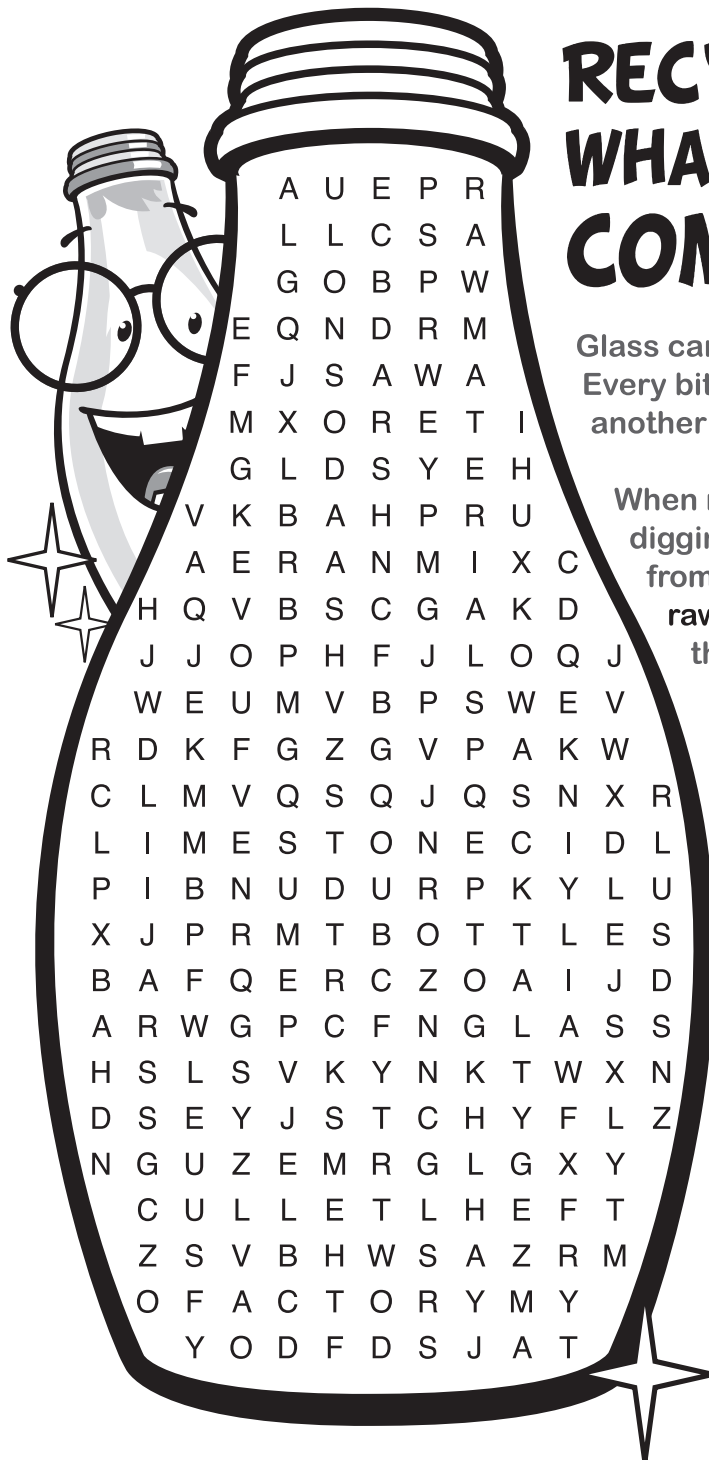

RECYCLING GLASS: WHAT GOES AROUND COMES AROUND!

Glass can be recycled over and over again. Every bit of a bottle or jar can be turned into another glass container.

When making glass containers, we rely on digging up limestone, soda ash, and sand from the ground; we call these things **raw materials**. The Earth has a bunch of these raw materials, but if we use more **cullet** (recycled glass from bottles and jars), we won't have to spend as much time or energy digging with big machines!

GLASS CONTAINERS AT THE SUPERMARKET

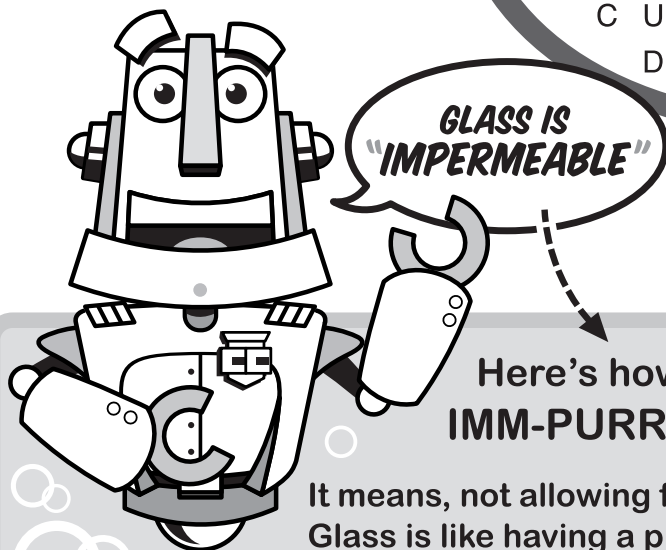
Most foods and all of our drinks have to sit inside a package or container before we eat or drink them. So, they need to stay **FRESH!**

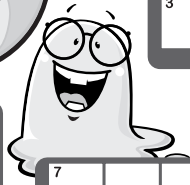

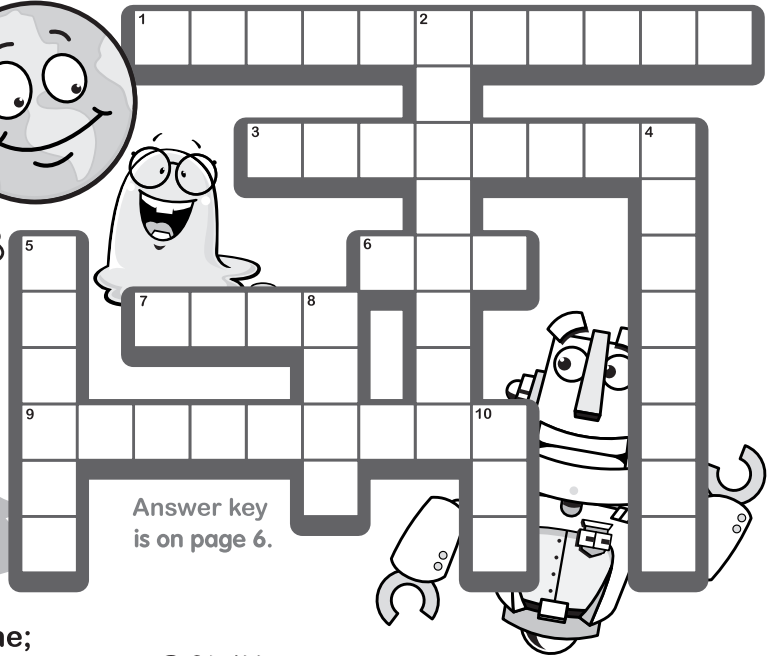
It means, not allowing fluid to pass through. Glass is like having a protective force-field around the food or drink inside!

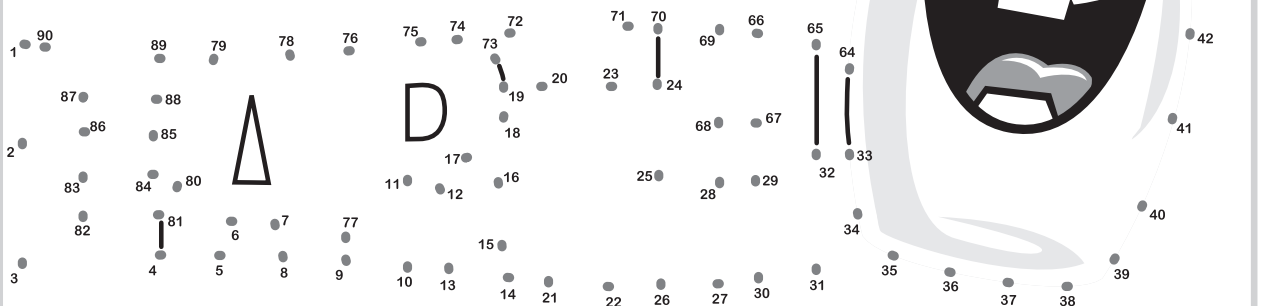

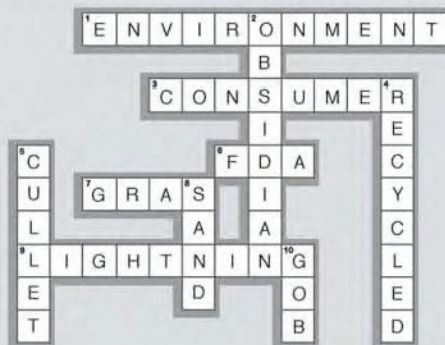
HOW DO YOU RECYCLE GLASS CONTAINERS?

Some companies will come by your house to pick them up and in some areas, there are recycling centers where you can drop them off. Also, look for recycling bins at schools, parks and other public places.

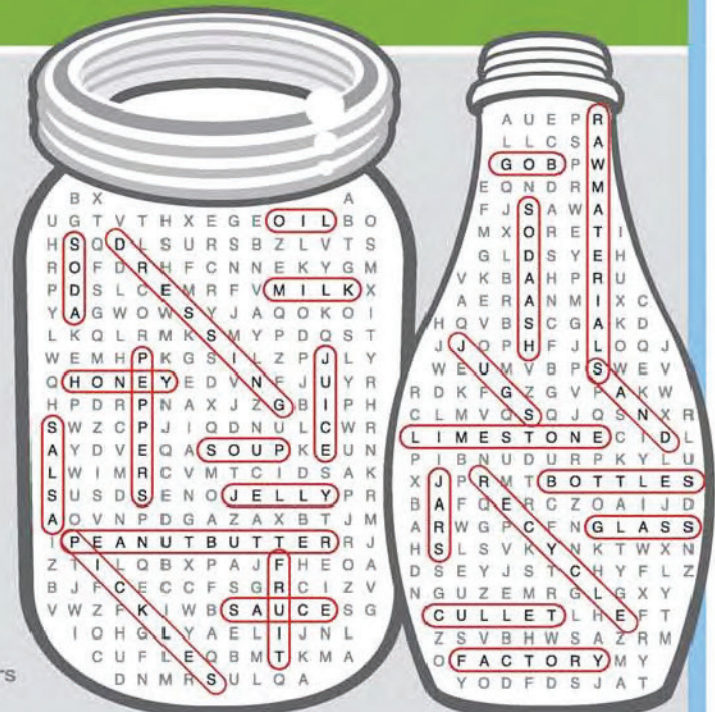
